

CDC awards \$109 million as part of 2020 *Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America* funding

In July 2020, CDC awarded \$109 million to accelerate progress in the fight to end the HIV epidemic in the U.S. as part of the federal initiative *Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America* (EHE).

In total, 32 state and local health departments—representing the **57 areas prioritized** for the first five years of the *Ending the HIV Epidemic* initiative—received funding to support **core EHE activities**. As part of this effort, CDC awarded \$3 million to **seven state and local health departments** to scale up quality HIV prevention services in STD clinics.

The following table breaks down recipients of both kinds of funding, as well as funding amounts:
